**Rules for SCDOS Member Displays**

1. The Exhibitor must fill out this form and check either Amateur or Open category. Orchid vendors must register in the Open category. Amateur growers can register in either category.
2. Each display needs to be entered as a Small or Large Display.
3. Forward your application to [president@sdorchids.com](mailto:president@sdorchids.com) or give to Debby Halliday at the Feb or March meeting. **RESPONSE DEADLINE: MARCH 04, 2022**
4. You will be assigned a position number on the table or floor for your display.
5. Reservations are on a first-come first-served basis. There may not be places for last-minute entries.
6. ONLY orchids, with the exception of greenery used as background or fill-in, may be used as plant material in displays/exhibits. Non-orchid flowers are prohibited. Other props are OK.
7. All orchids must be clearly labeled in a way that is easily visible to the observer. The use of number or letter keys is permitted.
8. A maximum of 7 (seven) flowering orchids used in an Exhibit may be entered in competitive Sections for individual judging. These should be pre-registered along with your other plants, checking the EX box on the entry form so we provide you with two name labels. The plants will need two registration tags (one tag on the table in the proper Section with "SEE EXHIBIT NUMBER #, the other on the plant in the display). Please ensure plants are tagged, and are easily accessible for judging. Plants not easily reached might not be judged. The Judging Chair reserves the right to remove any plant entered for judging for closer inspection and accepts no responsibility for any damage to the Exhibit resulting from this removal.
9. Displays will be judged on Originality, Show Theme, and Flower Quality. There are ribbons and prizes!
10. No flammable materials can be used.
11. Electrical outlets provided as available. Displays using electrical outlets must have a master shut-off switch located at the front of the display in a non-obtrusive place so that electrical devices may be turned off for non-show hours. (A power strip works well for this.)
12. All displays in the AMATEUR categories are eligible for the Orchid Digest Trophy.
